It's with great pleasure that we welcome you to the Faculty of Political Science and Sociology at the University of Granada.

Once you have been nominated by your home University as an Erasmus student for the 2025/26 Academic Year we will ask you in due time to fill out the online application whose instructions you will find in the following link:

Deadline: 15th May 2025.

Note that our catalogue of courses for 2025-2026 will not be available until mid-June. We do not expect significant changes in our current catalogue, therefore you should make a preliminary selection of courses based on our 2024-2025 catalogue (visit **Oferta académica/Academic offer**) in the above-mentioned link.

Some key dates follow for first term and academic year students:

- Lectures will begin on 16th of September (still to be confirmed)
- Recommended arrival date in Granada: around 8th of September 2025 (still to be confirmed)
- International Students' Welcome Induction Days: second week September

Second term students will receive further information in September. Online application for them will be available from 1st to 31st of October 2025

To be taken into account when completing your online application:

Remember that you will need to select:

- *Ciclo de Estudios: Grado*-Bachelor (even if you are Master student at home University, you have been selected under an agreement for undergraduate level)
- Año académico 2025/26
- Fase: Primera fase
- Programa de Movilidad: Erasmus
- Bachelor Degree: select either 212 Ciencia Política y de la Administración or 214 Sociología.



Do not select 219 Ciencia Política y de la Administración y Sociología or 224 Ciencia Política y de la Administración y Periodismo

As for our **courses taught in English**, they are displayed with their names in Spanish (no translation is available in the online application) because there are two groups in each course, one in Spanish and one in English and by now the platform does not offer the possibility to select either the Spanish or the English group. What should you do in case that you would like to be registered for the English course? Firstly, you must select the course with its name in Spanish. Secondly, when the academic responsible proceeds to validate your application, she will register all Erasmus incoming students in the English group. In case you would like to enroll in the Spanish group, please let us know by writing by end May an e-mail to oriceps@ugr.es





In case you come for whole academic year, please **select now all the courses** you would like to do <u>including</u> second term courses.

While the online application is open you will be able to make changes. After the 15th of May no further changes will be possible via online.

Finally, **by mid-July** all those who have followed successfully all the steps above will receive an acceptance letter.

COURSES AT OTHER FACULTIES

You would be able to choose courses taught at other Faculties always provided there are free places available (something we will know only when the registration process arrives).

When applying online (deadlines 15th of May and 30th of October), only a list of courses in Political Science and Public Administration and Sociology is available, so the final Learning Agreement will be fully completed once in Granada. You may combine courses from our three degrees, mixing years as well. In case that you would like to follow courses taught at other Faculties, you would need to register for them should seats in those courses be available. We would inform you in due time, In any case, you can include these courses on your Learning Agreement.
